





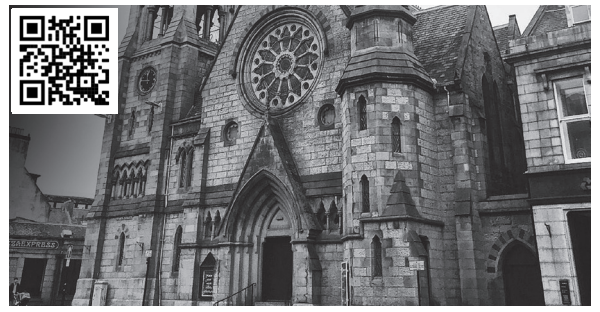
Fountain of Love
